



## **Resolusjon: Meat-free day at the SiB canteens**

Agriculture, through meat production, is one of the main contributors to the emission of greenhouse gases (GHGs) and thus has a potential impact on climate change" (Schwarzer, 2012). Therefore, meat consumption by the average individual should be reduced. Implementing a meat-free day per week at all of the SiB canteens can be used to increase the awareness about the meat production industry as well as to reduce meat consumption at the University of Bergen.

It is the opinion of the Student Parliament that:

- the SiB canteens should implement one meat-free day per week.
- the implementation of the meat-free day should be accompanied with an awareness campaign arranged by SiB on the benefits that are brought about by decreasing the consumption, and thus, the production of meat.
- the SiB canteens should offer more vegetarian food.
